Call for 2D & Wall Relief Works Artful Antics Exhibition Opportunities April 27 - October 30 2019

The Patchogue Arts Council calls for two - dimensional and wall hung relief work that embodies the spirit of this years festival season - *Artful Antics*. Artists are asked to submit works that are inspired by the seasons guiding themes of whimsy, humor, joy, and play. Works will be considered for a number of different exhibition venues that are incorporated into the *Artful Antics* Festival Season 2019.

Call for Poets, Performances & Costume Artists - Artful Antics Kickoff event April 27, 2019

The Patchogue Arts Council rolls outs its *Artful Antics* themed summer festival season with a 'Promenade' which takes for its inspiration the Ballets Russe' s groundbreaking work of 1917 'Parade.'Costuming and set for the performance were designed by noted cubist Pablo Picasso. It was for 'Parade' that the term surrealism was coined. Other notables associated with 'Parade' were choreographer Sergei Diaghilev and composer Erik Satie. 'Parade' was based on a scenario developed by future surrealist film maker Jean Cocteau. The performance captures the themes of PAC's *Artful Antics* summer festival; whimsy, humor, joy and play. Before long others would be creating similar pieces, one such being The Triadic Ballet created by Bauhaus artist Oskar Schlemmer.

Street performers, poets and costume artists whose work can be described as whimsical, humorous, joyful or playful or takes as its inspiration the art movements of Dada, Cubism, Surrealism and the Bauhaus are asked to submit proposals for creative costuming and performance. Artists who are selected to join in the 'Promenade' will receive an honorarium.

Call for Outdoor Sculptures – Artful Antics May 27 – October 30, 2019



The Patchogue Arts Council is pleased to announce it is accepting submissions from sculptors to exhibit an outdoor sculpture in Patchogue Village during the summer of 2019. Sculptures will be installed in the Patchogue Garden Club Community Garden from May 27 – October 30, 2019 as a component of Arts on Terry, a contemporary art street fair scheduled for June 23 on Terry Street adjacent to the Artspace facility. Additionally, sculptures will remain installed through the second week in October in coordination with the organization's *Artful Antics Festival Season 2019* (AAFS).

AAFS will explore whimsy, humor, joy, and play in art through varied media and disciplines including visual arts, dance, music, film and video in multiple venues in downtown Patchogue from April through October 2019.

Multiple sculptures will be installed in the Patchogue Garden Club Community Garden, and sculptors are encouraged to submit existing works or new works for consideration. Artists will be awarded a stipend for works that are selected. The Visual Arts Committee of the Patchogue Arts Council will review all submissions. All artwork will be on view outside, in public spaces, and must abide by safety protocol and procedures. All work must be constructed from materials that can withstand all types of weather, be appropriate for public spaces and impervious to interaction with the public.

The Patchogue Arts Council, in collaboration with the Patchogue-Medford Library, is pleased to announce it is accepting submissions from muralists to exhibit a temporary mural on the rear of the Patchogue-Medford Library. The mural will be inspired by this year's festival season theme *Artful Antics*.

The mural will remain on display throughout the Fall of 2019. The mural will be approximately 15 x 45 feet and should be executed in spray paint. Prior experience creating a mural is required. A stipend of \$2,000 will be awarded to assist in the planning, design, and execution of the mural. The mural should be inspired by the spirit of the theme *Artful Antics*.

The Patchogue Arts Council is seeking galleries who have uniquely creative voices. There is no submission fee, but an accepted gallery will be required to pay a \$250 participation fee. Gallery space includes preferred spot nearest the main festival, a 10x10 tent, table and two chairs for this special gallery vendor package. PAC takes no percentage of sales from booth. All participating galleries will be included in a comprehensive marketing plan that includes the following. The value of the marketing inclusions are valued at \$2500. Participating galleries are included as cultural sponsors.
