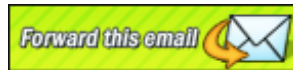

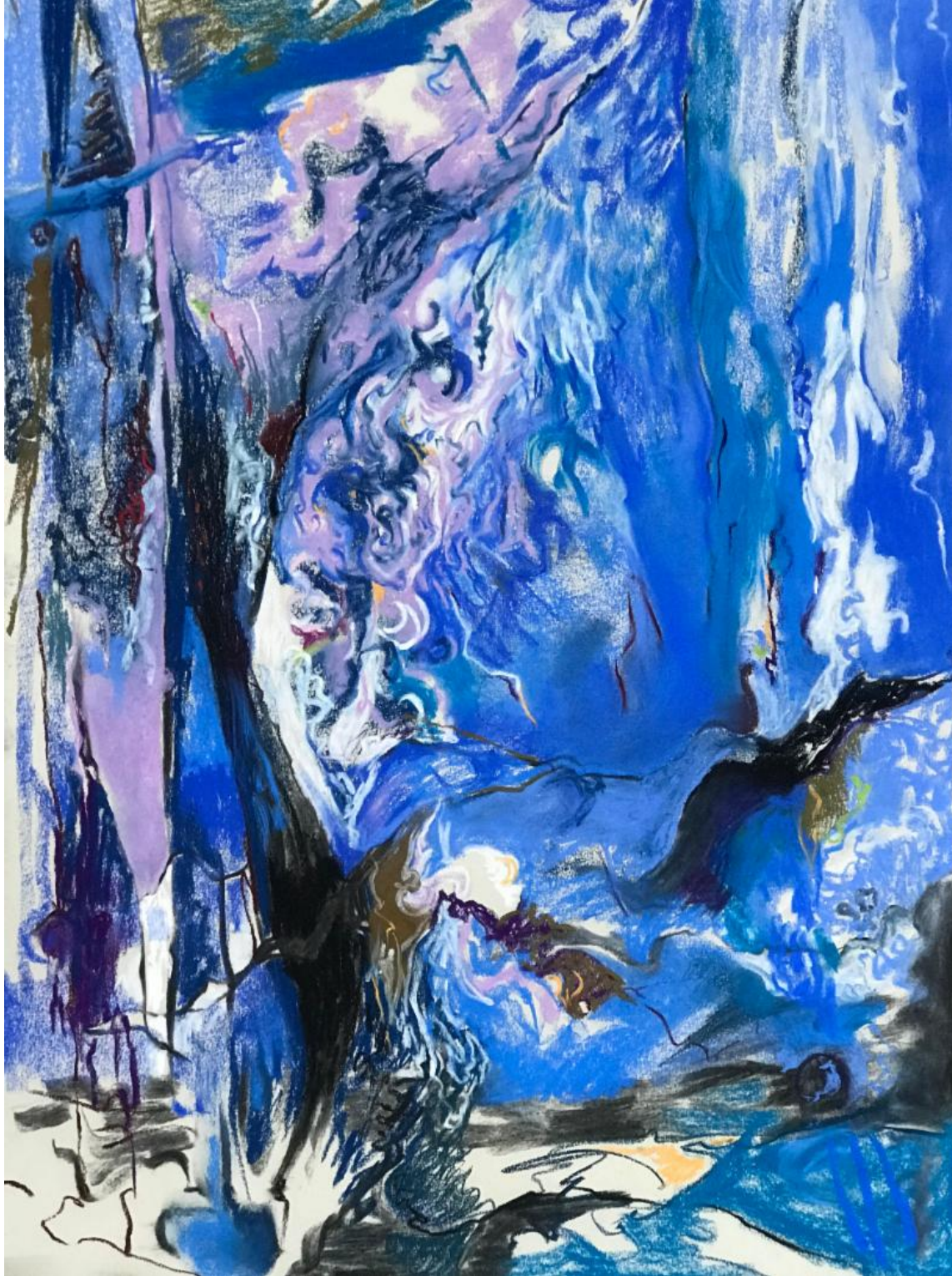
Excerpt from Constance Sloggatt Wolf's Artist Statement

"For me, abstract painting is a way of exploring the invisible-the unknowable or indefinable aspects of Life as I perceive it. Instead of words or sound, I use colors, angles, shapes and forms. I strive to bring forth the archetypal and essential in a painting through the repetitive use of the triangle, the circle, and the square-the most basic visual shapes that can be observed by all, but can be reinterpreted by the artist and acquire specific traits."
