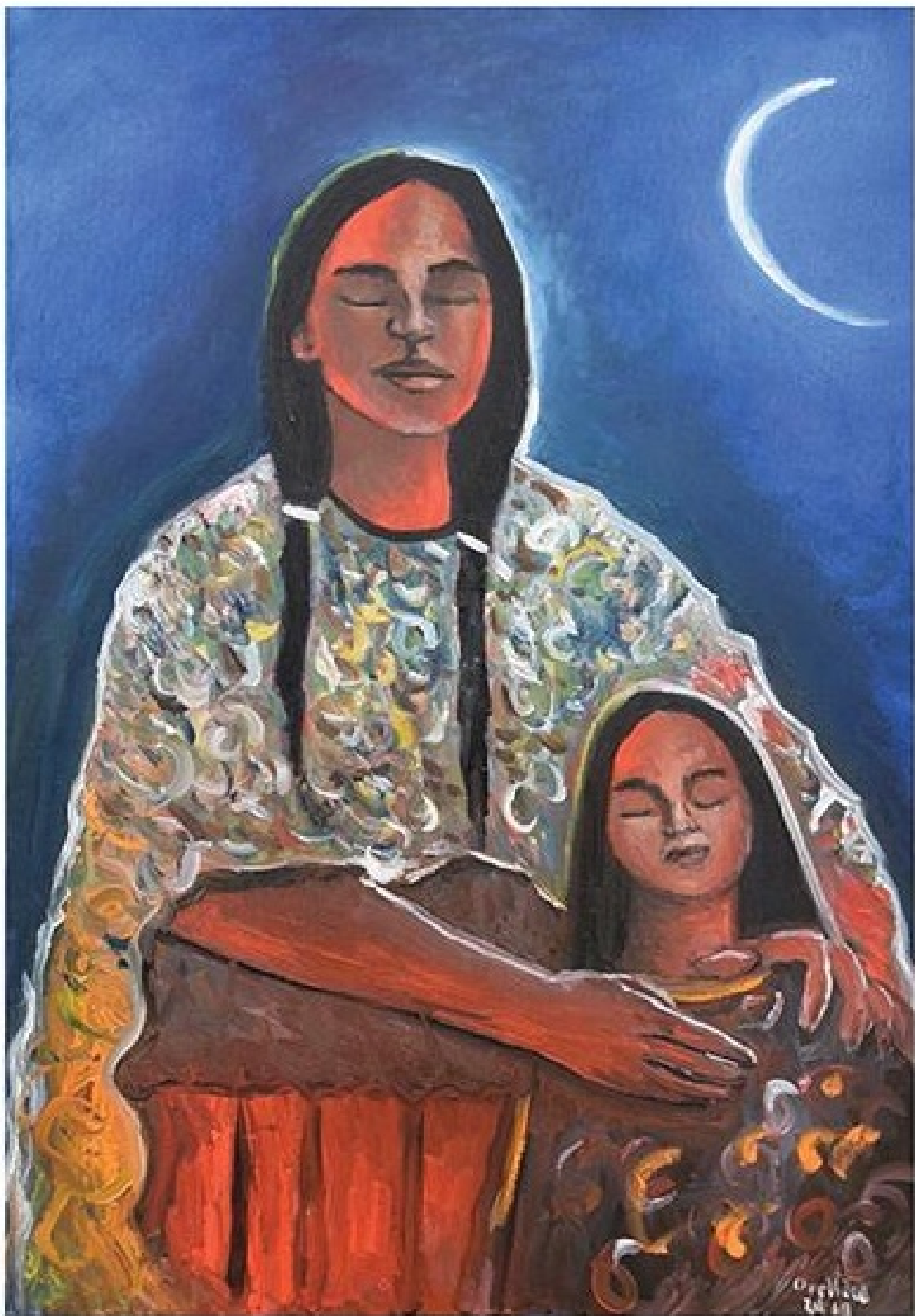

Orellana describes his inspiration for the exhibition *Latina* in two languages. "Esta exhibición es un homenaje y celebración a las mujeres latinas, quienes crean desde nuestra fuerza ancestral resilientes y amorosas. Hijas de la madre tierra nuestra Pachamama. This show is to pay homage and celebrate Latina women, who create with our ancestral force through resilience and love. Daughter of Mother Earth our Pachamama."

For his 2019 painting, *Ancestral Meditation*, Orellana writes "Yesterday I learned that the universe has many colors, many of them can only be seen through the eyes of the soul. Ayer Aprendí que el universo tiene muchos colores, muchos de ellos solo los puedes ver con los ojos del alma Meditación Ancestral."
