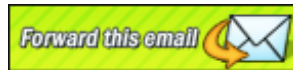

**PATCHOGUE, NY, March 8, 2019** - [The Patchogue Arts Council](#) (PAC) is proud present ***Latina: Paintings by Segundo Orellana***, an exhibit curated by John Cino, is on view in the newly expanded PAC Satellite Gallery at the Patchogue Theatre for the Performing Arts from March 9 - April 21, 2019. Ecuadorian Artist Segundo Orellana presents a variety of images of the feminine, from the mythic to the contemporary, portraying Latin American women in their strengths and struggles. There will be a reception that is free and open to the public on April 13, from 6:00-7:00 PM.

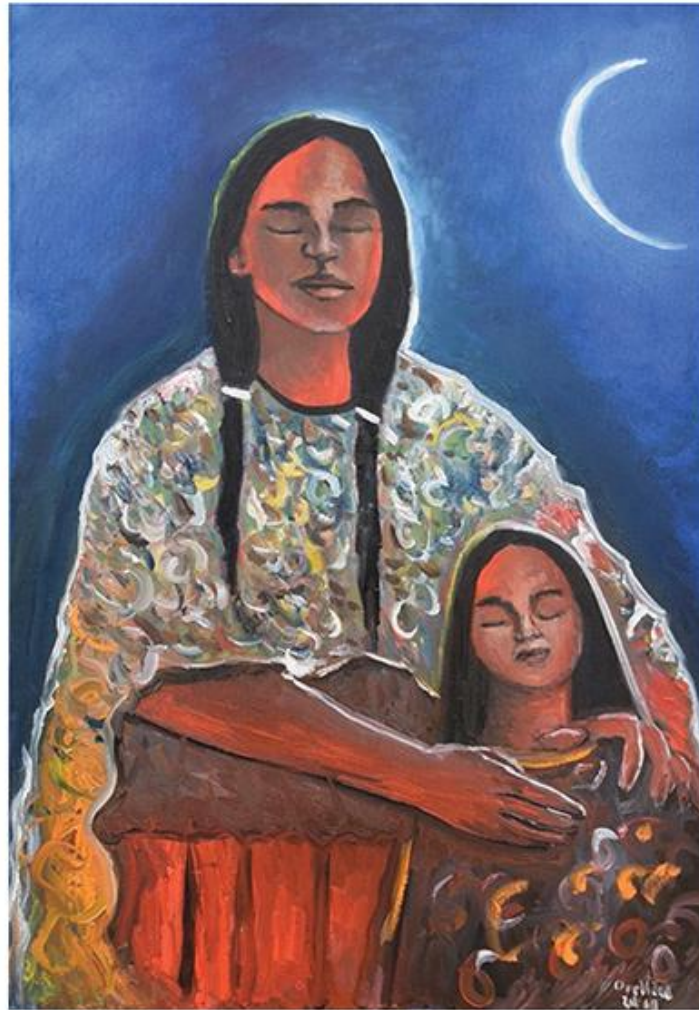
celebrate Latina women, who create with our ancestral force through resilience and love. Daughter of Mother Earth our Pachamama."

For his 2019 painting, *Ancestral Meditation*, Orellana writes "Yesterday I learned that the universe has many colors, many of them can only be seen through the eyes of the soul. Ayer Aprendí que el universo tiene muchos colores, muchos de ellos solo los puedes ver con los ojos del alma *Meditación Ancestral*."
