How To Submit your Work

Artists working in any media and all levels of their career are encouraged to submit. Please take the time to prepare your art ist package as requested.

We will be unable to accept and keep your package for review if it does not follow the guidelines listed below.

Digital submissions accepted only through our online form.

Work Samples | Images of one body of work

Select cohesive pieces of art. If you have multiple bodies of work, then submit a package for each body.

Each file must be labeled with your initials and title of work (EX: JC.Spacedust.jpeg)

Work Sample Detailed List

This list should include the Title, date, medium, price of each image you submit.

Related Artist Statement

This statement should reflect your conceptual ideas, process, and thoughts in regard to the works submitted.

2 Paragraph minimum

Artist Bio

This statement should be all about you and your experience. 2 Paragraph minimum

Artist Resume or C.V.

This can be short, simple, and should include exhibitions, talks, and lectures.
