MoCA L.I.ghts V will transform downtown Patchogue into L.I.'s only immersive, open-air museum with site-specific projected installations on both modern & historic architecture throughout the downtown to be viewed by the public at no cost on foot, by car, or live-streamed. Surrounding businesses will experience, rejuvenating and illuminating the Village for spectators of all ages. The work of over 100 local, national, and international artists of varied career

levels – emerging, mid-career, and well-established - will be presented through programs such as: Art on the Marquee (AoM), LIVE Experimentation Labs, **ARTchitecture, Night Visions Projected Pop-Up** Gallery (NVP), Themescape Activated, Garden of Sculpted deLights, projection inspired performances, and educational opportunities for artists interested in learning how to work in digital processes. In partnership with Cornell Cooperative and the Pat-Med Library, there will also be contemporary art & local history walking tours as well as onsite family friendly educational programs that coincide with a

It is imperative that programs like MoCA L.I.ghts continue offering the community inventive opportunities to engage with art for free and draw visitors from near and far to our Main Street. Additionally, 2024 will see entirely new additions to the festival! To celebrate its 5 year anniversary, MoCA L.I.ghts will present Glow Back, a special exhibition of every projection from past years – creating an opportunity for past artists and attendees to revisit their favorites from the festival since year one. 2024 will also see the launch of Garden of DeLight, a new site-specific projection highlighting the unique elements of the Sculpture Garden's architecture.

Other exciting ventures this year include an additional location of Art on the Marquee in Riverhead at The Suffolk; live performances; expansion of Interactive Projection Art Light Painting; nightly walking tours; and the launch of a MoCA L.I.ghts dedicated website. We are enormously proud to be collaborating again with unwavering partners like Greater Patchogue Chamber of Commerce, the Village of Patchogue, Patchogue BID, Patchogue Theatre for the Performing Arts, Pat-Med Library, and Cornell Cooperative Suffolk County & Marine Department, and more.

Art on the Marquee® **October 10 - December 31, 2024** (time TBA)

In collaboration with the historic Patchogue Theatre for the Performing Arts, PAC will utilize the marquee, which is typically used for information and marketing, to exhibit a curated selection of site-specific artist-created videos,

gifs, animations, and digitally created still works. Pieces for this program are curated from an international open call. Currently, it is also L.I.'s only digital marguee exhibition.

ARTchitecture October 10 - 14, 2024


Site-specific projections will illuminate the facades of contemporary and historic architecture, including some of Patchogue's most beloved buildings located throughout the downtown. Past ARTchitecture locations have included the Patchogue-Medford Carnegie Library and Main Street Library

facades, Industrial Coverage Building (former Union Savings Bank). Bank of America. United Methodist Church, and of course the home of PAC • MoCA L. I. -Artspace.

Night Visions Gallery October 10 - 14, 2024

An open-air pop-up projected gallery will be placed in various

locations throughout the Village of Patchogue, creating a unique art viewing experience for the community. Works included in this program will be curated from an international open call to artists working in all media, traditional and digital.



PAC's annual sculpture garden will be illuminated with projected colored light, making for an entirely new viewing experience for visitors.

Themescape Animated October 10 - 14, 2024

Every year, Patchogue Arts Council and the Patchogue-Medford Library collaborate to present a new mural on the southside of the main library building.

Nightly Live Glow Tours October 10 - 14, 2024

Meet at Carnegie Library under the PAC tent for a live docent led tour of the entire festival. Tours are free and open to the public.



Performances October 10 - 14, 2024

PAC will be curating new experiences with artists working in other disciplines such as music, dance, movement, and performance. For the first time, artists in these media will present works in tandem with projection installations.

Through a special collaboration with the Patchogue-Medford Library and Cornell Cooperative Extension of Suffolk, PAC will be offering unique educational opportunities and historical / contemporary art tours of locations used for MoCA L.I.ghts. Additionally, Virtual Labs will be offered for any community member-artists & non-artists alike-interested in experimenting with projection & animation as a medium in a series of workshops inspired by MoCA L.I.ghts installations and led by past artists. Virtual Labs are archived and re-released alongside each year's new offerings.
