## PATCHOGUE ARTS COUNCIL Call for Sculptures in the Garden for Patchogue Arts Festival October 1 –31, 2016

The Patchogue Arts Council is pleased to announce it is accepting submissions from sculptors to exhibit an outdoor sculpture in Patchogue Village during the **Patchogue Arts Festival 2016**, a downtown centric, multi-day, multi-venue festival encompassing music, visual arts, and cinema. The Festival will run between the dates of October 1 – October 31, 2016 in Patchogue, NY.

Multiple sculptures will be installed in the **Patchogue Garden Club Garden** and sculptors are encouraged to submit existing works for consideration. Artists will receive a stipend from \$500.00 to \$750.00 for works that are selected. The Visual Arts Committee of the Patchogue Arts Council will review all submissions. All artwork will be on view outside, in public spaces, and **must** abide by safety protocol and procedures.

### Submissions Details

- Email submissions due ON September 18, 2016
- Submissions received AFTER September 18, 2016 will not be considered
- Accepted artists will be notified through email by September 23, 2016
- Subject line must include: **PAFSculpture2016\_ArtistName**

- Only submission to this email address will be considered

### Email Submission Guidelines

- Please submit 2 images total of sculpture using the following specifications
- All files should be labeled with your name and title of work. Ex: Yourname\_titleofwork.jpg
- Please include the dimensions, and detailed installation instructions for each work
- The body of your email must include the image details: Title, medium, size, and date
- All artists must include: CV/resume, bio, artist statement.
- Submissions that do not follow ALL of the above guidelines will not be considered

## **Requirements & Restrictions**

- Collaborations are permitted, but stipends are per sculpture - not per artist
- There is no fee to submit work
- All artwork must survive unpredictable weather for one month
- Only digital submissions sent by September 18, 2016 will be considered
- Submissions must include images for existing work

## **Important Information**

- **September 18: Submission Deadline:** Submissions must be sent to [info@patchoguearts.org](mailto:info@patchoguearts.org) by this date
- **September 23: Artist Notifications** – Artists granted public space to exhibit their sculpture will be notified via EMAIL by a Patchogue Arts Council representative.
- **September 24 – September 30: Temporary Sculpture Installation** – Artists will be expected to install their sculpture between these dates
- **October 1 – October 31: Exhibition Dates** – PAC MAC Festival will be held in Patchogue, NY between these dates.
- **November 1 – November 8: Removal of Artwork** – Artists will be expected to retrieve their installation/sculpture between these dates.
